### Ba Na Hills

Crowned the most exciting project in Vietnam, this Fantasy Park mountain top resort complex is just a short trip from downtown Danang. Ride the world record cable cars, stroll through the medieval French village, visit Le Jardin D'Amour Garden, and walk over the legendary Golden Bridge with views of Danang city in the distance.

### Hoi An

### Nen Restaurant

If you're planning a love affair with Vietnamese cuisine, or are already fully enamoured, this restaurant is a 'must-visit' hidden gem tucked away from the city centre. Specialising in degustation menus, the restaurant celebrates the best of Vietnamese cuisine, offering refined, creative and experimental versions of some great local dishes ideal for those who want to explore the cuisine.

### Morning Glory

Housed in charming example of Hoi An's historic premises, this eatery is owned by one of the city's leading restaurateurs and draws an impressive crowd most evenings so prior booking is advisable. Serving a selection of authentic local cuisine, the restaurant comes with a backstory and is named after one of Vietnam's most important staple foods.

### The Market

The same owner as Morning Glory, this eatery offers a great opportunity to explore some of the different flavours of Vietnamese cuisine. With an open food-court set up and different stalls to take a stroll around, the venue has a street-food market atmosphere and offers the chance to see how dishes are prepared before served.

## MUST-DRINK IN DA NANG



### Pasteur Street Hoi An

Lauded as the brewer that put Vietnam on the craft beer map, this tap house serves a fresh brew straight from the source. With outlets in Saigon and Ha Noi, their Hoi An tap room sits on the riverfront in one of the city's historic houses, and offers the ideal spot for an early evening tippie as the world wanders by.

### Oasis Tapas bar

A low key hang-out that attracts a trendy crowd of local expats and city visitors for a tempting selection of authentic tapas, signature cocktails, cold beers and premium gins. Located in the heart of An Thuong Village, it's described by some as the city's friendliest bar, they play a funky, up-tempo choice of music with regular DJ sets.

### Sky 36

If you're planning an evening of decadent partying, then Danang is home to Vietnam's highest rooftop bar where you can get your groove on in complete luxury. Music policy is loud and up-tempo, and the drink prices match the extravagance of the venue, but with stunning views of the city and bay this is a place to visit.
